

THAINSTONE, Aberdeen and Northern Marts (Friday 6th September 2024) Sold 799 Store Cattle, Young Bulls and Young and Weaned Calves & Breeding Cattle.

“799 head of cattle was sold at the weekly sale incorporating the annual show and sale of Aberdeen angus cattle kindly sponsored by the Aberdeen angus society. Sheep Park farms won the championship with a 26-month-old bullock sired by Skail Dalton which fetched £2260 weighing 676kg and sold to the Judge Frank Fowlie, Bogenjohn, Strichen. The reserve overall also went to Sheep Park for a 562kg steer which stood 2nd prize to the champion, he scaled 565kg and sold for £1780 to D & V Buchan, Savoch. Steers sold to 349.8p per kg for a 446kg single from Bain, Hall of Tankerness. Heifers topping at 355.6p for a 450kg from Smith, Upper Cornquoy. A smart 408kg British Shorthorn Cross Heifer sold for 372.5p per kg & £1520 from Grant, Gaskbeg. Trade for all classes continued to be strong & wanted.”

Bullocks (252) averaged 303.8p and sold to 358.8p per kg for a 464kg Limousin Cross from Formouth, Tomintoul and £1895 gross for a Pen of Three 634kg Charolais Cross from Rockyden, Meikle Wartle.

Aberdeen-Angus Bullocks (180) averaged 294.6p and sold to 349.8p per kg for a 446kg from Hall of Tankerness, Tankerness and £2030 gross for a 726kg from Hallbreck, Grimness.
